SAR-SR LIAISON

The SAR-SR Liaison Committee encourages and assists chapters across the state to help promote membership and joint events/community service between our Florida Daughters and the Sons of the American Revolution (SAR) and Sons of Revolution (SR).

In an effort to promote membership, be mindful of *potential new SAR and SR members*. You and other chapter members may have husbands, sons, grandsons, brothers, uncles, family and friends that qualify for membership. When a DAR member refers a prospective member to an SAR chapter, it's important that the SAR Finder Form (DAR FF 11-2017) be completed and included with the prospective member's SAR application. DAR members need to make sure that this form is included when the application is sent from the local SAR chapter to the state SAR Society. Awards from the National Society Sons of the American Revolution (NSSAR) are presented to the DAR State Society that recruits the most new members to the SAR. Also, many SAR Chapters present Certificates of Appreciation and medals to recognize your efforts. So always be thinking if there is anyone that could qualify for the SAR and/or SR.

We are *striving for at least fifty percent of our Florida Chapters and Regents' Councils to participate in events or community service with SAR and SR Chapters and their members*. Examples include providing color guard support for events, posting colors, providing speakers and programs for chapter meetings, cooperating on activities such as flag events, citizenship, historical preservation, genealogy workshops, education and patriotism. Be sure to keep a log of your activities and send a copy of the event program or a summary of the joint event to this Chair via email or snail mail (pictures would be great too). Remember these activities when completing the Florida Honor Roll Form and CMR. Accurate reporting for STATE CONFERENCE is needed in order to properly recognize the chapters and members with Certificates of Appreciation. Remember that your State Chair is always available to assist you so please reach out via text, phone or email.
